Take diagnostic SAT and ACT It's best to use official tests from the College Board and the ACT. Find a few hours ove a weekend to check this off your list—the earlier the better!
Arrange standardized testing tutoring as needed For more information about tutoring, please visit commandeducation.com/tutoring.
Take AP/IB exams Study smart! Once you're finished, you'll feel that your schedule is much lighter. Take the time to rest, but also take advantage of the extra time you have to research colleges before final exams and projects are due!
Research colleges & draft a college list Reach out to your guidance counselor and parents as you compile an initial list of 3 safety, 5-7 match, and 5-7 reach schools.
Ask for letters of recommendation  It's important to start this conversation before the school year ends, so make sure to connect with your potential recommenders during the spring semester.
Finalize summer plans  Determine which summer opportunities you'll be involved in and confirm your seat at any program, course, research opportunity, etc.
